

Social Media, Gender and Student Attitudes toward eLearning

This study was conducted to address the following question: Does gender impact overall attitudes toward eLearning? After surveying 80 college students at a public university in Japan, we found that there's not a gender difference in terms of attitudes toward eLearning except for attitudes toward blended learning. To our greatest surprise, computer self-efficacy, privacy concerns and attitudes toward Facebook use for academic purposes were not different at all. We think the gender gap is disappearing because of the ubiquity of smart phones, tablets and broadband technologies.
